

Can you find it?

(Game to observe closely)



<u>Target group</u>	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Empty toilet rolls for the children to help them look for details.
<u>Procedure</u> 10 min	<p>The children will have to look for 20 different details from Park Güell (some details from the park and some from the city).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- All the children are gathered around the teacher in a particular place in Park Güell that we have chosen.- The teacher asks the children to find a particular detail (eg. the teacher asks a child to look at the city and find a yellow house).



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The children show everyone what they have found. - The teacher gives a new detail to find (this will go on until they have found the 20 different details). - The children give their impression about the activity (was it easy or hard to find details, why?).
<u>Variations</u>	- Children are in small groups (3-4 children). Each group has to choose a detail then describe it to another group that has to find it.
<u>Aims</u>	<p><u>Socio-emotional competence:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn to collaborate in a common project (listen to the others' propositions, discuss) <p><u>Competences to observe the environment:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Learn to observe in detail. <p><u>Language:</u> (mother tongue): develop vocabulary to express what you feel.</p>
<u>Comments</u>	This game will be part of a whole game we do in Park Güell. That is why it goes for 10 minutes, there will be other games after this one.
