

Target group	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	No material, only the body
<u>Procedure</u>	The teacher has got different objects, but she wants them in the order of size (from the longest to the shortest). She asks the children for help, but they can't use any material. They can only use their body. They measure the different objects (pots, chairs, tables,) After they have measured the different objects they can put them in the right order.
<u>Variations</u>	Big or small objects, they can measure only with the hand or maybe the legs to make it more difficult.
<u>Aims</u>	Mathematics: The children can measure the different materials or object by using their body. It makes them aware how big or small something is.
