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| <u>Material</u> | Pictures from different things (buildings, benches,) you can find on the street. Puzzle (from one picture) |
| <u>Procedure</u> | The teacher tells the children that she lost her way to a beautiful place that she wanted to show the children. She only has pictures from the places that she saw on her way there. She asks if the children want to help her to find the place. The children get one picture, and they need to find the place that is on it. If they find it they get another picture until they are at the place the teacher wanted to show them.
