

<u>Target group</u>	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	One picture cut into pieces (the picture represents a place or an object from the city or the park) + the number of the pieces depends on the age of the children. The pieces are spread over the park or place we will visit. Arrows
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul> <li>We take the children to a park or place in the city, the teacher says that she has lost pieces of a puzzle when she was there previously.</li> <li>On the puzzle there is a picture of a statue or of an object the teacher wanted to show the children.</li> <li>The children follow the arrows to find the different pieces of the puzzle.</li> <li>When they have found all pieces they make the puzzle and look at the picture.</li> <li>Now they have to find what is represented on the picture.</li> </ul>
Variations	- We can do the same activity at school so they can get used to it and so they know where everything is.



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	- There are some fake puzzle pieces to make it harder.
<u>Aims</u>	- Visual : The children need to look closely to find the arrows and the pieces of the puzzle.
