


# Same letters for names



<u>Target group</u>	5 to 6 years.
<u>Material</u>	Nothing.
<u>Procedure</u>	Children stand in a circle. One kid says his name (for example, Loren), then the child standing next him has to find an animal starting with the first letter of his friend's name (for example: lion).
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One kid has to say his name and animal name with the first letter of his name</li> <li>• Second kid has to repeat his friend's name and the animal with the same letter. Then he says his own name and an animal name with the first letter of his name</li> <li>• Third kid has to repeat 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> children's names and animal names and after that he has to say his own name and animal name...</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• It helps to know each other better;</li> <li>• And it's good for the memory.</li> </ul>
