



Target group	5 years old
<u>Material</u>	<ul> <li>Some objects found in the park or in the city (leaves, stones, flowers, bottles)</li> <li>A box (to put the objects)</li> <li>Scarf to blindfold a child</li> </ul>
Procedure	Children are in a circle. The guard is in the middle with the box next to him and he is blindfolded. Children must go and take (one after one) an object in the box without waking the guard. So they can't make noise.
<u>Variations</u>	
<u>Aims</u>	<ul> <li>⇒ To calm the children</li> <li>Competences to observe the environment:</li> <li>- Refine one's auditory perceptions:</li> <li>• Listen to the silence, to sounds</li> </ul>
<u>Comments</u>	If the activity is too easy, the children can imitate the wind to have some noise.



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
