Target group	5 to 6 years.
Material	Ears ©
Procedure	 Children sit in the circle (outside) Close their eyes; Listen to what they hear; Teacher goes around the circle and then she touches one child's head, the child has to say what he has heard.
Variations	Teacher can reverse this activity. For example: children can sit in a circle, back inwards, children have to cover their ears and look at what they can see. Then teacher touches one child's shoulder; this child has to say what he sees.
Aims	It helps to distinguish view/sounds and identify them; to concentrate and know the environment ©
