



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 5-6 years old.
<u>Material</u>	<ul> <li>Park Güell</li> </ul>
Procedure	<ul> <li>In Park Güell we are going to play in the place where there are the columns. One child has to choose a column and will count to 20.</li> <li>The others will have to hide behind the other columns. They will have to touch the column the counter has choosen to save themselves but, also they have to say something they have seen (a colour, a shape) while they were looking for a</li> </ul>
	safe place in order not to be found.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul> <li>One of the teachers may be the person who counts to 20.</li> <li>They have to say adjectives, objects, people they have seen or feelings they have experimented.</li> <li>The person who gets to touch the column without the counter's knowledge, has to join the counter to look for the rest of the people.</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	$\circ$ Learn to look at things from another perspective.
