



| Target group      | Age - 5 to 6 years old  |

| <u>Material</u>   | -Large paper.<br>-Glue or two faced cellotape.<br>-A pen.   |
| Procedure         | Create a collage with different elements that kids can find in the<br>park. If they are supposed to create a city for example, they will<br>have to fill the shapes (ground, trees, stones) with the natural<br>stuff : grass, sand, stones and two faced cellotape to glue them. |
| <u>Variations</u> | -The teacher can draw the picture and they will have to fill<br>it in.<br>-Some of the children can draw the pictures and the rest<br>can fill it in.<br>- Everybody can draw on the same large paper their own<br>city and then, we will compare the results.                    |
