## Make a tree



Target group	• Age: 3 - 6
<u>Material</u>	<ul> <li>Paper;</li> <li>Brown ink;</li> <li>Leaves;</li> <li>Flowers;</li> <li>Anything you can find in your environment.</li> </ul>
Procedure	<ul> <li>The teacher gives the children a sheet of paper and asks them to make a tree with ink;</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>When the drawing is dry we go outside in a park or in the street and ask the children to pick up some things that they can put as leaves and flowers on the tree;</li> <li>We give the children some freedom to pick all things they want even if it does not makes sense in a (stereotyped) tree.</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	<ul> <li>Ask them to do a tree of things of the city;</li> <li>To do the tree of their dreams;</li> <li>Do a tree with drawings, pictures, objects the things we like the most.</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	<ul> <li>Children get to know more about their environment;</li> <li>They experiment well-being in nature;</li> <li>Distinguish different characteristics of materials;</li> <li>And learn to look at things from another perspective;</li> <li>They also observe, compare and discover colours, shapes, materials.</li> </ul>
