

Make a tree



<u>Target group</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Age: 3 - 6
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Paper ;• Brown ink ;• Leaves ;• Flowers ;• Anything you can find in your environment.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The teacher gives the children a sheet of paper and asks them to make a tree with ink ;

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When the drawing is dry we go outside in a park or in the street and ask the children to pick up some things that they can put as leaves and flowers on the tree ; • We give the children some freedom to pick all things they want even if it does not makes sense in a (stereotyped) tree.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask them to do a tree of things of the city ; • To do the tree of their dreams ; • Do a tree with drawings, pictures, objects the things we like the most.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children get to know more about their environment ; • They experiment well-being in nature ; • Distinguish different characteristics of materials ; • And learn to look at things from another perspective ; • They also observe, compare and discover colours, shapes, materials.
