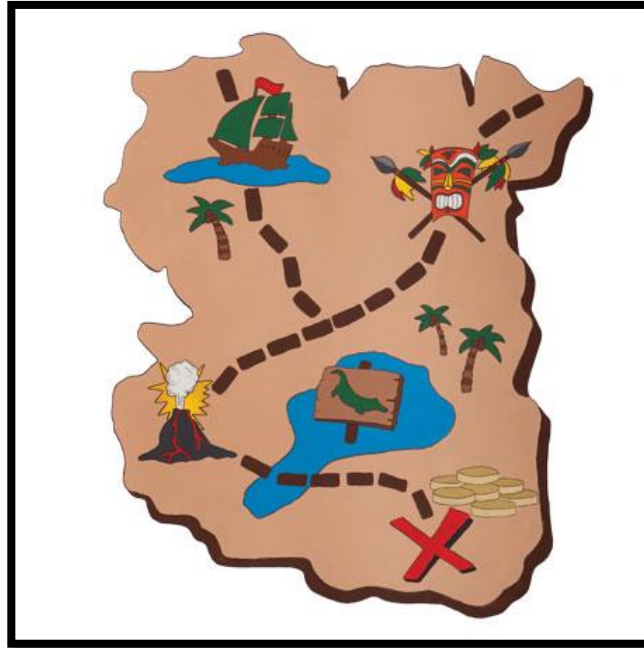


Map



<u>Target group</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Age: 3 - 6
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Map already done with the points to find ;• Images (treasures) that define the points.• Clues to help find the treasures
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The teacher divides the children in several groups and gives them a map with treasures situated in different places ;• We give them some elements to find the place where each treasure is and they have to find where each treasure is ;• To end we ask the children to draw the elements that we they have found in the right place on the map.

<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Instead of drawing on the map, the children glue different pictures in the right places
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The children discover objects from the nature, colours and shapes ; • They experiment well-being in nature ; • And learn how to collaborate in a common project • They discover that a map is a representation of a part of our environment
