



Target group	• Age: 3 - 6
<u>Material</u>	<ul> <li>Map already done with the points to find;</li> <li>Images (treasures) that define the points.</li> <li>Clues to help find the treasures</li> </ul>
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul> <li>The teacher divides the children in several groups and gives them a map with treasures situated in different places;</li> <li>We give them some elements to find the place where each treasure is and they have to find where each treasure is;</li> <li>To end we ask the children to draw the elements that we they have found in the right place on the map.</li> </ul>

<u>Variations</u>	Instead of drawing on the map, the children glue different pictures in the right places
Aims	<ul> <li>The children discover objects from the nature, colours and shapes;</li> <li>They experiment well-being in nature;</li> <li>And learn how to collaborate in a common project</li> <li>They discover that a map is a representation of a part of our environment</li> </ul>
