



Target group	3-5 years old
<u>Material</u>	 Bottle of 1.5 liters of water; Three containers with different volume capacities.
<u>Procedure</u>	'Experience water volume', where you have the same amount of water in 3 different containers • Experience with the same volume of water in different containers; • Ask the children what they think about the quantities: same, different?

	• Discuss the results of experiments conducted as observed and draw conclusions.

Aims	Sciences: be curious, ask oneself questions, use one's senses to discover, observe to get to know better; Mathematics: count in order to observe. Discover that the same amount of water can 'look' different in different containers.
