



Target group	4-5 years old.
Material	A sheet of paper with a simple drawing (ex: the sun)  Elements of the nature (leaves, branches,)  A camera.
Procedure	<ol> <li>At first, the children look at the drawing.</li> <li>Then, they go and pick up a lot of elements in the nature like leaves, branches, stones,</li> <li>Afterwards, the children look at the drawing and try to make the same drawing or the same shapes with the elements of the nature.</li> <li>When they have finished, the teacher can take a picture of the creation of the children.</li> <li>Then, they can leave the creation there and maybe someone will see it.</li> </ol>

<u>Variations</u>	<ul> <li>We can also, ask the children to search for leaves, branches, stones, to bring back to the classroom.</li> <li>Then, the children can make land art on a sheet of paper, with glue and all the things they have brought from the nature, and express their creativity.</li> </ul>
Aims	<ul> <li>Get used to natural materials. The children will understand that we don't need necessarily chemical things to make art.</li> <li>Look around and find all the things from the nature they can use for their artwork.</li> <li>Make links between the children.</li> </ul>
