

# Land art



<u>Target group</u>	4-5 years old.
<u>Material</u>	A sheet of paper with a simple drawing (ex: the sun) Elements of the nature (leaves, branches,...) A camera.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) At first, the children look at the drawing.</li><li>2) Then, they go and pick up a lot of elements in the nature like leaves, branches, stones,...</li><li>3) Afterwards, the children look at the drawing and try to make the same drawing or the same shapes with the elements of the nature.</li><li>4) When they have finished, the teacher can take a picture of the creation of the children.</li><li>5) Then, they can leave the creation there and maybe someone will see it.</li></ol>



<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We can also, ask the children to search for leaves, branches, stones,... to bring back to the classroom.</li> <li>• Then, the children can make land art on a sheet of paper, with glue and all the things they have brought from the nature, and express their creativity.</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Get used to natural materials. The children will understand that we don't need necessarily chemical things to make art.</li> <li>• Look around and find all the things from the nature they can use for their artwork.</li> <li>• Make links between the children.</li> </ul>
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
