



Music queen

<p><u>Target group</u></p>	<p>5 - 6 years old children</p>
<p><u>Material</u></p>	<p>Musical instruments: tambourine, cymbals, claves, bell / bell, reco-reco.</p>
<p><u>Procedure</u></p>	<p>A person is chosen (first the teacher, then a child) to play the queen, she walks and moves to the sound of the instruments. All her subjects follow her. When she is tired, she sits and children imitate her. After a moment, another child takes over the queen's role.</p> <p>Go singing the following rhyme:</p> <p>"Pim, pam, pum, Each ball kills one Hen turkey pro Who really you free! "</p> <p>Each instrument represents a movement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tambourine - hit the floor with palms together. • Dishes - hitting with hands on tights. • Claves - jump . • Bell / Bell - run freely. • Reco-reco - walk and do firecrackers fingers simultaneously.



<u>Variations</u>	One can add more instruments, which makes the game more complex.
<u>Aims</u>	Develop musical expression Recognize musical instruments Develop memory, reflexes and coordination of movements.
