Discovering hature elements







Target group	5 years old
<u>Material</u>	-newspapers -camera -masks (so that you can blindfold the children) -blanket

	-photographs of different mosaics
Procedure	1. Walk through the park First we go to the park/forest and walk around and look around. Then we make a big circle so that we can talk and explain what we are going to do.
	2.Newspaper The children are blindfolded and they receive a newspaper. You ask them to think about a tree or a flower or anything that they have seen during the walk through the park/forest. You ask them to rip the paper and make the form of the thing that they are thinking about.
	When they have finished, you lay down all the ripped papers and look at them. The children guess what it is.
	If it is too difficult, they first do it without being blindfolded and then in a second step they do it again being blindfolded.
	3.Mosaics After this exercise the children go and find all sorts of nature materials (flowers, branches, leaves, stones,). They collect as many things as possible and lay them on a blanket in the circle. We look at them and tell what we see. The teacher shows pictures of different mosaics and they discover together what a mosaic is. The idea is that the children make their own mosaic together with all the materials that they have collected earlier.
<u>Variations</u>	 You can discuss the details in all the materials they have collected in the park/forest You can classify the materials
<u>Aims</u>	<u>Social -emotional competences</u> -get to know others, establish relationships with others

Competences to observe the environment -tactile -discover one's body in relation with the environment -learn to observe in details -learn to compare Competences in the different subject areas in order to discover the environment -art -art Comments - Make sure you go to a big park/forest so there's a lot to see - Make sure that you make rules and restrictions about the area the children can go to in the park/forest - Make sure that children only collect things on the ground and not pick up flowers ...
