

drawing different lines



<u>Target group</u>	3-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Long roll of paper- crayons- sticky tape
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Search for a place in the city with a wall or a flat ground.- Make pairs and let the children look around to observe the lines in the surroundings.



	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Let the kids find a wall where they can stick their paper on or a part of the floor. - They should think about different kinds of lines. - Long strict lines, waving lines, thick or thin lines,... - They should draw the whole paper full with different lines. - At the end there will be a lot of colours with different lines, - The children can see what ideas the other kids had. It looks good on a wall in a room.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Out of this paper you can cut out some shapes and for example make a collage. - Use watercolours or other different things to draw
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Searching for different lines - To get reminded of earlier seen pictures. - Be creative. - Work in an artistic way with the material
