drawing different lines







Target group	3-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	 Long roll of paper crayons sticky tape
<u>Procedure</u>	 Search for a place in the city with a wall or a flat ground. Make pairs and let the children look around to observe the lines in the surroundings.

	 Let the kids find a wall where they can stick their paper on or a part of the floor.
	- They should think about different kinds of lines.
	- Long strict lines, waving lines, thick or thin lines,
	 They should draw the whole paper full with different lines.
	 At the end there will be a lot of colours with different lines,
	- The children can see what ideas the other kids had. It looks
	good on a wall in a room.
<u>Variations</u>	- Out of this paper you can cut out some shapes and for
	example make a collage.
	 Use watercolours or other different things to draw
Aims	- Searching for different lines
	 To get reminded of earlier seen pictures.
	- Be creative.
	 Work in an artistic way with the material
<u>Comments</u>
