


Finding shapes in the city



<u>Target group</u>	5 years old
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Camera - Paper - Pencil, Pens, ... - Mirrors - Binoculars -
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Go to a place in a city where you have space to sit and to discover the surrounding. - Tell the children how far they are allowed to go, - Let them describe the place in their own words. - Talk about shapes. Which shapes do they know? (triangle, circle, square, ...)



	<p>Why we are here?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We will make a little documentary about the buildings and the elements on the facades and structures we can see. - Search for some shapes all around the place. On the walls, on the floor, in some shops. Make photos from them or draw them on some paper. - Bring them all together and talk about these forms, what is typical for them? <p>At the kindergarden or in the city you can print the pictures.</p> <p>All together sort them out, classify them, make some posters which the kids can show to some other children from their group or the parents, grandparents,...</p> <p>Talk about some other shapes.</p>
<p><u>Variations</u></p>	<p>Find more specific shapes</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Find some ornaments</p> <p>Let them think about things in the nature with this kind of shapes.</p> <p>If you do not go to a special place you can do it in the kindergarden as well.</p>
<p><u>Aims</u></p>	<p>First images of geometric forms</p> <p>Learning how to use a camera</p> <p>Find elements in the environment and become awake of looking for something.</p>
<p><u>Comments</u></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - You can bring some pictures with examples of the shapes, for a better understanding.
