

Form details with clay



<u>Target group</u>	3-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Modeling clay- A place in the city where you can find windows or other things like walls, post boxes, stones on the street,...- A camera
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Let the children look around at the floor or the walls, trees...- They should use their creativity and imagination to find shapes which look like something else.- To make it easier for the other persons to see, they should fix it with just a few little details. See photograph : a stone + some details to make a cockerel- They can explain their ideas and how they have found what it could be.



<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This can be done in the nature as well, with stones, sticks and other natural materials. - In the city there are a lot of things fixed with some screws or nails. Normally with two. So the children can imagine that these screws are the eyes and can model them into a face.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use the imagination and fantasy - Need to search for details. - Work with modeling clay or clay and get to know the material - Take a picture of the child and the thing he has done.
<u>Comments</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Use different colours of modeling clay. - Make a picture and take the clay afterwards back home.
