<u>Target group</u>	Age: 5-6
<u>Material</u>	Pictures about paintings of Picasso, Miró and Gaudí.
<u>Procedure</u>	The teacher shows pictures about paintings of Picasso, Miró and Gaudí, and children have to find in them some shapes that they think that they can also find in the town. Then, they have to explain to the rest of the class what they found it in each picture.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Children can look at the pictures about paintings of Picasso, Miró and Gaudí, and then they will have to find some shapes that they can see in the city
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Recognize and accept difference (ideas, opinions...) - Learn to collaborate in a common project (listen to others) - Discover shapes and colours in the nature. - Discover the town world (buildings, stairs, walls...) - Situate in space to refine one's observation.
