

# Draw the sounds



<u>Target group</u>	4 - 6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Same papers, crayons and scarves.
<u>Procedure</u>	First, children have to sit on the ground and they must be silent. Then, the teacher gives the scarves to the children and explains to them that they have to wear the scarves and they have to listen to the sounds around them. After that, the teacher gives them one piece of paper and crayons and tells them that they have to draw what they have heard.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- When children listen to something blindfolded, they have to imitate with their bodies this noise or sound.</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Dare making new experiences in the nature (listen to the nature and the city)</li> <li>- Learn to identify elements from the environment by listening them.</li> <li>- Listen to the silence, to sounds.</li> <li>- Distinguish sounds and identify them.</li> </ul>
