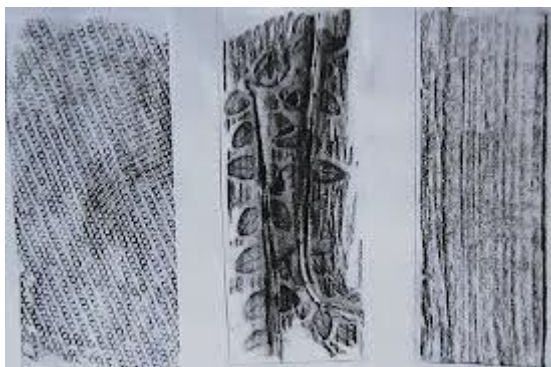


# Frottage domino



<u>Target group</u>	5 years
<u>Material</u>	Oil pastels Sheets of paper with a line to separate them into two
<u>Procedure</u>	<p>First, children use the frottage technique to create dominos: Children have to find different places with special reliefs. They put one sheet on the special relief and rub with the pastel on the half sheet to make it appear. They do this with all the sheets. To be sure that we can play, they have to do all their reliefs on two different sheets.</p> <p>When everybody has finished, we play the domino game: children have to find the same relief and make a big way with them.</p> <p>Pay attention to the relief: surfaces must be very different to bring up the different characteristics (with lines, with circles, completely irregular ...) so that there is no hesitation later on in the domino game.</p>



	Everything is done with the same colour to be sure than the children are not influenced by it.
<u>Variations</u>	Change the colour for all reliefs to make a "colour domino" with the little ones and a "relief domino" with the older ones.
<u>Aims</u>	Get to know others, establish relationships with others  Refine one's tactile perceptions: learn to distinguish different characteristics of different materials
