

<u>Target group</u>	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Pictures of different things.
Procedure	All the children get a picture of something or somebody. They look at the picture, and tell a story from what they see in the picture. The teacher can write down the stories and print them next to the pictures.
<u>Variations</u>	The children can perhaps sit in a circle, and the first child shows his picture, it then goes around in the circle. The first child starts the story, and the next continues and so on. The teacher has taken pictures from the city and they do this activity before actually seeing the pictures in the reality. The children take pictures from a walk in the city and use them like this afterwards.
<u>Aims</u>	The children get to use their imagination. They also have to listen to the other children to remember the story.
