

Blindfolded (A2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4 - 6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Scarves
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Make pairs - Blindfold one child - Don't speak - One child is the guide, and the other is the blind person - The guide is the eyes of the blind child. He has to be at the same level as the child who's blind. - The guide leads the blind child through a limited environment. And the blind discovers the nature around him by the other senses. - The guide and the blind exchanges roles.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The guide lead the blind child to certain spot.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - When arrived, the blindfolded child touches everything around him. - The guide leads the blind child back to the departure point. - The blind tries out the spot where he was.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Observation with the others senses (not eyes) - Be empathic - Understand body language - Become aware of kinaesthetic information
<u>Comments</u>	<p>The children can choose their partners They have to be free. If they don't want to play the game, they can just be a guide or observe. Don't punish the children who don't want to be blindfolded!</p>

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
