

Complete the picture (A2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	Colour pencils or natural elements Paper A3

	Pictures of the nature that you can complete Glue
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The children need to take a paper, a picture and pencils. - They lay there picture on the paper and they glue it. - Then they can start drawing above, under and next to the picture. - After this the teacher can make a picture of it. - You can also do an exhibition of all the children's works and parents can visit it.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Instead of drawing the children can use the elements of nature to complete the picture. The elements should look like the things on the picture. When the child is done the teacher can take a picture and there can be an exhibition, too. - The children can use the nature to draw. They can use grass for green, berries for red, flowers for any colour, dirt for black, the tree for brown, grey from stone, orange from stone... When you do this go to the forest or some other place first to collect everything. - When the children are older (6) they can take their own pictures and then they can use them for their new work of art. You have to tell the children in advance what the picture will be used for, in this case complete it. You (as a teacher) can give an example to the children so that they really see what the intention is.
<u>Aims</u>	<p>Observe the picture and establish connections Create around the picture by using imagination.. Use different senses to distinguish different characteristics of different materials.</p>
