



« treasure »

Target group	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	Forest objects are «treasures» such as leaves, sticks, rocks, etc.
<u>Procedure</u>	 The teacher delimits one space. Then she shows an object that she has chosen. The teacher explains the activity to the children. They close their eyes and she hides the object. All the children search the « treasure » and when one child finds it, he wins the game.
<u>Variations</u>	- You can have two groups of children and two places

	delimited. One of them hides the «treasure» in their camp and the other group does the same. At the end they need to find the other group's object. - Instead of forest objects, the teacher can use a prize that she had made or bought.
Aims	 Learn to identify elements from the environment and touch them. Develop the observation and the comparison between similar objects. Learn to situate in a specific space.
