Storytelling (B1)



Target group	Age : 4-6 Group : 10
<u>Material</u>	Piece of abstract land art
<u>Procedure</u>	 Before the activity, the teacher has prepared a piece of abstract land art standing alone in the nature. The teacher writes or rewrites a story that he



	 associates with his land art creation. He does it in an easy and logic way, so that the children can easily understand the meaning. The teacher tells the story that in some way associates with his land art. The teacher points out that in a story there is a beginning, a middle part and an end before the children begin with their own creations → and explain the storytelling principles he used for his creation to make it concrete and easy to understand.
<u>Variations</u>	 The children can be inspired by the teacher's story and start their own creations from it. The teacher asks the kids to do the same with their creation. The kids tell their newly invented story to the rest of the group.
Aims	 Language: invent a story based on objects found in the nature Listen to the others. Use imagination, creativity.
