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| <u>Target group</u> | Age : 5-6  |
| <u>Material</u>     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Paper</li> <li>- Pencils (different colours)</li> <li>- Markers</li> <li>- Pastels</li> <li>- A real map (for example)</li> </ul>   |
| <u>Procedure</u>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Tell a part of a story about secrets in the forest (stop somewhere)</li> <li>- Explain to the children how to create a map for a treasure island</li> <li>- Let them work to make themselves maps</li> <li>- Finish the story together</li> <li>- After that, you can start another activity in connection with the secrets in the forest.</li> </ul> |
| <u>Variations</u>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Make 3 teams to let each team imagine something</li> <li>- Children can stick their maps all together to see how the roads can be connected</li> </ul>  |
