

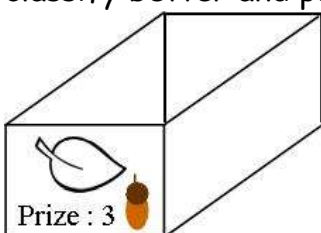
The natural shop (B2)



<u>Target group</u>	Age : 4-6
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cord- White sheets- Little treasures found in the forest- Camera- Small (fake) shop in the classroom- Boxes, labels, pens
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- In the forest, the teacher puts a cord to make a limit for the children and asks them to find little treasures and to put them in the bucket.- The teacher asks the children to classify all the treasures on a white sheet.



- "How can we do a shop with that?" discussion with the children
- Make a little shop with the children and have fun. Show them how to play
- Go back to the classroom with everything they have found. Put all the categories on a table and make photographs.
- Make new boxes for the shop, stick the photograph to classify better and put prices



- Make money for the shop usin some acorns
- Invite another class to play with the natural shop.
