

# Land art (C1)



<u>Target group</u>	All ages
<u>Material</u>	Flowers, stones, leaves, woods... Picture of the land art built by the teacher Books about land art
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- The teacher has built land art in the forest.</li><li>- The children go into the forest.</li><li>- They can see pictures about land art.</li><li>- Then they have to look for the land art that the teacher has made.</li><li>- The teacher asks questions for example: "What materials did I use to build it?" "What do you see?"</li><li>-</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- They get a checklist so they can find all land arts</li> <li>- After they can try to build them</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Children look in land art books in the class and choose one which they will try to build.</li> <li>- Children go to the forest.</li> <li>- Children in groups collect materials to build the chosen land art</li> <li>- Children look at each other's works of art, look in the books and try to see what the inspiration was.</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	<p>Observe different materials from the land art and describe them</p> <p>Use their memory to remember pictures of the book and transfer it to reality</p>
