Target group	Age : 3-6
<u>Material</u>	Landscape
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul> <li>The teacher makes two groups.</li> <li>Each group has to choose and observe one part of the landscape.</li> <li>They have to represent it with their bodies, like a picture (for example: a river, a tree and a bird)</li> <li>The other group has to guess what they are representing.</li> <li>Then they have to change.</li> <li>The teacher puts music and when it stops children have to represent what they did before.</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	- The teacher puts music and when it stops children have to represent what they did before.

	- One group has to draw a landscape and the other group has to represent it.
Aims	<ul> <li>Learn to observe in details and find out similarities.</li> <li>Learn to work in group, collaborating with others.</li> <li>Discover one's body in relation with the environment.</li> </ul>
