

# Music with natural materials (C1)



<u>Target group</u>	3-6
<u>Material</u>	Wood, yoghurt glasses or cups, stones, grass, branches, etc.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Take the children to the forest</li> <li>- Tell them you will make music instruments with yoghurt glasses</li> <li>- They can choose and look around for different materials and find out about differences in the sounds</li> <li>- Then they put their favourite material in the yoghurt glass</li> <li>- They show it to the other kids</li> <li>- Everyone compares the sounds</li> <li>- They have to try to make music with them</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- With the teacher's help they can try to make different kinds of rhythms</li> </ul>
<u>Aims</u>	Act and produce using the elements of nature to discover different ways of producing sounds
