## Musical Story (C1)





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Target group	4-6
<u>Material</u>	Instruments (drums, tambourine, triangle, flute, etc), pictures (animals from the story, e.g. pig, chicken, cow, tiger, lion, elephant, etc.)
Procedure	<ul> <li>The teacher divides the class in for example 4 groups. Then he gives each group a picture ( see material) (the teacher has the same pictures for herself)</li> <li>the teacher tells a story about the animals in the pictures and shows the picture from the animal she is talking about</li> <li>the children have to recognize the picture and plays with the instrument a similar sound as the animal makes</li> <li>when they have heard the story several times the teacher does not show the pictures anymore</li> <li>The children have to know from which animal is she talking about and play the music at the right time</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	- don't tell a story about animals, but about people, and the instruments from the children then represent the characters.

<u>Aims</u>	- develop one's visual and auditory memories - create the auditory background for a story
