

Musical Story (C1)



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<u>Target group</u>	4-6
<u>Material</u>	Instruments (drums, tambourine, triangle, flute, etc), pictures (animals from the story, e.g. pig, chicken, cow, tiger, lion, elephant, etc.)
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The teacher divides the class in for example 4 groups. Then he gives each group a picture (see material) (the teacher has the same pictures for herself) - the teacher tells a story about the animals in the pictures and shows the picture from the animal she is talking about - the children have to recognize the picture and plays with the instrument a similar sound as the animal makes - when they have heard the story several times the teacher does not show the pictures anymore - The children have to know from which animal is she talking about and play the music at the right time
<u>Variations</u>	- don't tell a story about animals, but about people, and the instruments from the children then represent the characters.

<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- develop one's visual and auditory memories- create the auditory background for a story
