

# Learn a new song (C2)



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| <u>Target group</u> | 4-5 years  |
| <u>Material</u>     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Fluffy kangaroo.</li><li>- The song of the kangaroo.</li></ul>   |
| <u>Procedure</u>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Children familiarize themselves with the fluffy kangaroo and while doing this they have to make it jump while the teacher is playing the song.</li><li>- After they have moved the kangaroo they have to learn the lyrics.</li><li>- When the kangaroo looks at the teacher, she sings and then, when the kangaroo looks at the children, they can repeat what the teacher has said.</li><li>- They sing all the song with instrumental music.</li></ul> |
| <u>Variations</u>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Another animal and another song.</li><li>- They can invent some lyrics and another way to learn the song, for example, without music or fluffy toy.</li><li>- When one group of children has to repeat the first sentence, the others have to say the second sentence and so on.</li></ul>   |

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| <u>Aims</u>     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Discover intensity, rhythm, pace and beat.</li> <li>- Develop vocabulary.</li> <li>- Memorize words.</li> <li>- Refine audition perception.</li> <li>- Respect the others and know about the turn of speaking (e.g.: when the teacher sings, children have to stay quiet and they know when it's their turn).</li> <li>- Be attentive.</li> </ul> |
