

Making an animal (C2)



<u>Target group</u>	5 years
<u>Material</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- A big piece of wood, e.g. a trunk lying on the ground- All kinds of material from the nature.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Bring children in front of the big piece of wood while they take a walk.- Children take a look at the piece of wood and decide what animal they want to make on it.- They have to use their imagination and the material from the nature they can find around. To do a face, legs,...- Take pictures to present it to the parents or another class.
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Make a story about the animal they have created.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Other material for the foundation (like stone,...) - Sing a song about the animal, invent one
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Develop creativity - Get to know others, establish relationships with others, learn to collaborate in a common project. - Learn to look at things from another perspective - Use objects from the nature to illustrate a story, a song - Situate in space to refine one's observation
