| <u>Material</u>  | Some material from the nature: stones, braches, leaves, chestnuts, CD player CD with music   |
| <u>Procedure</u> | <ul> <li>All the materials lie in the room on the floor.</li> <li>The teacher plays a song on and the children walk around.</li> <li>When the children hear only music they have to walk. When they hear somebody singing they can take an item and make some 'music' by themselves.</li> <li>When the music stops they have to put everything back on the ground.</li> <li>Then the children go and sit in a circle. Every child takes two stones.</li> </ul> |

|                 | <ul> <li>The first child makes a sound with the two stones.</li> <li>The rest of the group has to repeat the sound of this child.</li> <li>Now the second child makes a new sound.</li> <li>And so on.</li> </ul> |

| Variations      | <ul> <li>The children can also use other materials to make the sounds in the circle. For example: branches, chestnuts,</li> <li>At the end the children can make their own sound all at the same time.</li> </ul> |
| Aims            | <ul> <li>Learn to compare</li> <li>Act and produce using elements of the nature</li> <li>Discover different ways of producing sounds.</li> <li>Discover rhythm, pace and beat.</li> </ul>                         |
