

Blind walk



<u>Target group</u>	Children from 3 to 6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Scarves to blind fold
<u>Procedure</u>	<p>All participants are in a line with hands on each other's shoulders. All are blindfolded except the one in the front. Now</p> <p>The front person leads the others around the terrain.</p> <p>The blindfolded children say where they think they are, they say what they hear and smell.</p>
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Take an adult to say where they should go- Make smaller groups- Make a competition
<u>Aims</u>	<p>To focus on the surroundings using other senses than the sight</p> <p>Gain trust, and relations.</p>
<u>Comments</u>	Change from time to time the person who leads.
