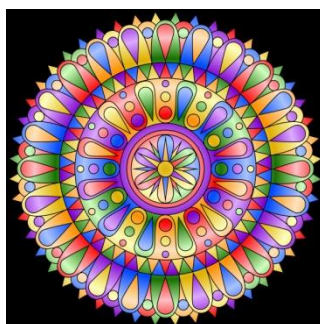


# My nature mandala



<u>Target group</u>	5-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Elements found in nature (leaves, sand, stones, flowers, ...)
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We go for a walk in a parc with the children. Four or five groups are formed and each group collects a different element.</li> <li>- When all the elements are gathered we go back to the school and classify them.</li> <li>- We choose a spot in the school and create the mandala (each child will place one or several elements).</li> <li>- The teacher takes pictures.</li> </ul>
<u>Variations</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- We create a permanent mandala by sticking the elements on cardboard.</li> </ul> <p>Each child creates his own mandala (small one) to take home and offer for mother's day,...)</p>
