

# My tree friend (clay work in nature)



<u>Target group</u>	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Clay, nature elements: leaves, stones, bark, Camera to take pictures.
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Each child receives a piece of clay, and they each choose a tree.</li><li>- They put the clay against the bark to form the shape of a face.</li><li>- Then they search for elements from nature to make a face (eyes, nose, mouth, ears,...)</li></ul> <p>They can give a name to their creation and present it to the group</p>
<u>Variations</u>	- Use one material to make the face (stone, pine,...)
