

What do you hear?



<u>Target group</u>	5 to 6 years.
<u>Material</u>	Ears ☺
<u>Procedure</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children sit in the circle (outside) • Close their eyes; • Listen to what they hear; • Teacher goes around the circle and then she touches one child's head, the child has to say what he has heard.
<u>Variations</u>	<p>Teacher can reverse this activity. For example :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • children can sit in a circle, back inwards, • children have to cover their ears and look at what they can see. • Then teacher touches one child's shoulder; this child has to say what he sees.
<u>Aims</u>	It helps to distinguish view/sounds and identify them; to concentrate and know the environment..... ☺
