

Stick it!



<u>Target group</u>	Age - 5 to 6 years old
<u>Material</u>	-Large paper. -Glue or two faced cellotape. -A pen.
<u>Procedure</u>	Create a collage with different elements that kids can find in the park. If they are supposed to create a city for example, they will have to fill the shapes (ground, trees, stones...) with the natural stuff : grass, sand, stones... and two faced cellotape to glue them.
<u>Variations</u>	-The teacher can draw the picture and they will have to fill it in. -Some of the children can draw the pictures and the rest can fill it in. - Everybody can draw on the same large paper their own city and then, we will compare the results.
<u>Aims</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Art. ○ Discover colours, shapes, materials, textures... ○ Use objects from the nature to illustrate a story, a song...
<u>Comments</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A warming up to motivate the children may be a story about the elements of the city, how it looks like, how many things
