<u>Target group</u>	5 years old
<u>Material</u>	/
<u>Procedure</u>	In groups of 4, children should be placed looking at the four different wind directions. Each one should say something that he can observe, smell, hear and, finally, feel about the environment. The golden rule is about not repeating the words that they have already been said. The one who fails, repeats, leaves the place and another player replaces him/her.
<u>Variations</u>	After the activity, children could invent a story based on the objects/feelings/sounds that they have mentioned during the game.
