<u>Target group</u>	4-5 years old.
<u>Material</u>	A camera.
<u>Procedure</u>	<p>Children do the activity outside.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) They have to open their eyes and watch all around them to find the shapes of objects or animals in the nature. Then, the children can take pictures of what they have found to catch the moment and have memories.2) When they come back in the classroom the teacher can print the pictures and the children can choose a picture and put a transparent paper above the picture. Then they can take a pencil and draw the shape of the picture.3) Then they can take the <i>transparent</i> paper and put a paper

	of colour under their drawing to see only the shapes.
<u>Variations</u>	When they have found a shape in the nature, the children can also try to make a sculpture of this shape with <i>plasticine or clay</i> and then take a picture of it to have memories.
