<u>Target group</u>	4 to 6 years old children
<u>Material :</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - One sheet of paper per child - One pencil per child - One blindfold per child
<u>Procedure :</u>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Put the blindfold on your eyes and listen to what you can hear. Try to identify what you are hearing to tell the others afterwards. 2) Draw something that is here and that we can eat. Draw with details so that we can recognize your drawing. 3) With all the drawings, try to imagine a menu, something that we could prepare.
<u>Variations :</u>	In another place, we can draw typical elements in places of food and invent a story with them.
<u>Aims :</u>	The first part developed our auditory perception .
