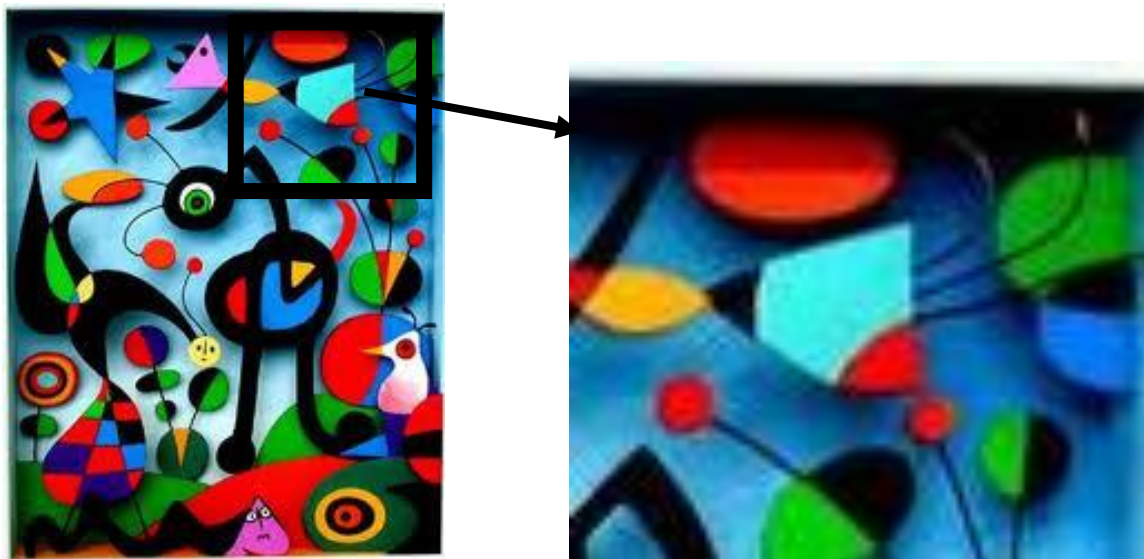


Painting Museum

| <u>Target group</u> | 4 to 6 years old |
| <u>Material</u> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Some painting of an artist - Paper or cardboard shapes to observe in detail like squares, circles ... - Sheets of paper - Pencils - Paints and paintbrushes |
| <u>Procedure</u> | To discover and observe an artist (his main characteristics, his techniques ...), the children have to select a form and put it somewhere on the painting. They have to paint or draw everything that they see in that form. |
| <u>Variations</u> | After they have discovered an artist, the children have to make their own painting like this artist (the same technique, |
