

# Picture story

<u>Target group</u>	4-6 years old
<u>Material</u>	Pictures of different things.
<u>Procedure</u>	All the children get a picture of something or somebody. They look at the picture, and tell a story from what they see in the picture. The teacher can write down the stories and print them next to the pictures.
<u>Variations</u>	<p>The children can perhaps sit in a circle, and the first child shows his picture, it then goes around in the circle. The first child starts the story, and the next continues and so on.</p> <p>The teacher has taken pictures from the city and they do this activity before actually seeing the pictures in the reality.</p> <p>The children take pictures from a walk in the city and use them like this afterwards.</p>
<u>Aims</u>	The children get to use their imagination. They also have to listen to the other children to remember the story.
